

Pearls

Socken-Kreativ-Liste - November 2007



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Size 36/37 - 38/39 - 40/41

Materials

100 g of sockweight yarn in black
Set of 5 dpn, 2,25 - 2,5 mm
1 crochet needle in 0,6 mm
17 g rocailles, 2,7 mm, in silver

Gauge

30 M x 42 R = 10 cm x 10 cm

Leg

With a thin crochet needle thread 440/440/488 rocailles on your sockweight yarn and shift them an arm length.

Cast on 60/60/66 stitches, divide evenly over 4 dpns and join without twisting. If necessary shift the rocailles again.

Work the Pearl pattern as written in the chart and knit the leg up to a length of 12 cm in stockinet stitch.

Heel

Work a heel with the stitches of dpn 1 and dpn 4 in short rows:

Knit all stitches of dpn 4&1, turn, slip 1st stitch and pull thread tightly backwards. There will be a doubled stitch on your needle now. Purl all stitches of dpn 1&4, turn, slip 1st stitch and pull thread tightly backwards.

In the following rows work in stockinet stitch and turn work just before the doubled stitch without knitting it. Work short rows in this way until there are 10/10/11 doubled stitches on both dpns.

Knit 2 rounds over all stitches and take care to knit each doubled stitch as one stitch.

For the 2nd part of the heel knit 21/21/23 stitches, turn, slip stitch with pulling the thread backwards, purl 11/11/12, turn, pull thread backward. In the following rows work 1 stitch above the doubled stitch, turn and double this stitch again. Continue in this way until the 1st stitch of dpn 4 and last stitch of dpn 1 is doubled.

Foot and Toe

Continue to knit in rounds up to a length of 19,5/20/21,5 cm.

Ktog 2nd- and 3rd-last stitch of dpn 1 and dpn 3 and ssk 2nd and 3rd stitch of dpn 2 and dpn 4.

For the classic toe shaping use the following decreasing scheme:

1x each 4th round, 2x each 3rd round, 3x each 2nd round and 6/6/7x each round after the first decreasing round. Pull together the last 8 stitches. **Don't forget the 2nd one!**

Knitting with beads in stockinet stitch

With a thin crochet needle thread rocailles on the sockweight yarn and shift them an arm length.

Take about 20 rocailles nearby. To knit a stitch with bead shift 1 rocaille up to about 5 mm to right needle, enlarge the stitch with the right needle, pull bead through the stitch with the middle finger of your left hand and knit stitch. The bead takes place at the right side of the stitch but may slip to the left side quickly.

In the following round take care to keep the bead beneath both needles.

Now each rocaille found it's place!



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
